

CWG – Extra Information

Belmont Street Construction Working Group (CWG)

Construction vehicles will enter Crogsland Road from the north via Prince of Wales Road. The vehicles will then be held within the construction delivery pit lane within Crogsland Road whilst they complete their delivery

A zebra crossing will be situated ahead of the northern end of the pit lane to ensure safe crossing for the public.

On completion of the delivery, the vehicles will exit the delivery pit lane and head south on Crogsland Road. At the junction of Crogsland Road and Haverstock Hill, the vehicles will turn left on to Chalk Farm Road.

Construction working hours will be as follows.

08:00 – 18:00 Monday to Friday

08:00 – 13:00 Saturday, in agreement with London Borough of Camden.

Residents, where possible, will be issued a notification if we plan to work on Saturdays within the restricted times above.

No working on Sundays and Public Holidays.

Any deviation to the permitted working hours will be subject to agreement with London Borough of Camden.

All contractors have been told that there will be no parking on site or within Crogsland road or Belmont Street and have been strongly advised to take public transport. This is stipulated within the trade contractor order and in the pre-start meetings held. Constant reminders are being issued.

Communication going forward will be the same with monthly Resident Newsletters, notifications being delivered when required. Noticeboards with all this information will be on the hoarding in various locations and will be updated when needed.

Hoarding is currently being installed, once complete, a full security camera system will be in place. The cameras will detect movement and a central database will be alerted. The intruder will be given a warning and the police called if required. The security guard and dog will no longer be on site during the evenings.
